


Quality of Life Tracking Graph

The Quality of Life (QOL) Tracking Graph is intended to be used in conjunction with the Quality of Life Assessment Tracking Chart. By utilizing the totals from the tracking chart, you can follow your pet's QOL progress over time.

How to use the graph: The x-axis (horizontal) denotes the day of the month, while the y-axis (vertical) reflects the daily total points for your pet from the Quality of Life Assessment page tracking chart. A total score of 24 signifies excellent quality of life and likely a content pet, whereas a score of 0 indicates very low quality of life, and likely some or a significant degree of struggling or suffering.

Consistent charting and graphing offer a visual depiction of your pet's quality of life progression. This method eliminates the need to rely on memory for tracking your pet's daily changes. While fluctuations are common, families often observe sharper declines, fewer inclines, and shorter periods of stability as their pet approaches a point where euthanasia becomes a strong consideration. It's crucial to emphasize that there's no specific number suggesting when to consider euthanasia. Instead, this decision should be carefully weighed when your pet's quality of life no longer meets a level that is acceptable to your family.
